

BIG WORDS for Little People



Can a young child learn these words and have them become part of their vocabulary? If they can learn dinosaur names, then **YES, THEY CAN!** Build these words into your everyday conversations.

ACCEPTANCE

is loving or liking people just the way they are.



BELONGING

is being part of a group and being loved and accepted for who you truly are.

BOUNDARIES

are your rules to help keep you safe, heard and respected.



CONSENT

is when one person asks for permission, like 'Can I have a hug?' and the other person saying 'yes' or 'no'.

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CURIOSITY

is when you want to learn more about something or someone. Asking questions helps you grow and understand the world better.



DIVERSITY

is different kinds of people who may look, speak or act differently or come from another country, and the world is a better place for them being part of it.



EMPATHY

is showing kindness and understanding to another person or living creature.



EQUALITY

is where all people are treated the same — no matter their gender, what they look like, where they may come from or their ability.



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GENEROSITY

is being kind and giving.

INCLUSION

is accepting all peoples with love and joy — no matter their gender, what they look like, where they come from or their ability.



JUSTICE

is when everyone has the right to be heard and to be safe.

KINDNESS

is doing something nice for someone else to make them feel happy and loved.



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PATIENCE

is waiting calmly and understanding that good things take time.



PERMISSION

is asking if something is okay or not okay.



RESPECT

is listening to others and caring about what they think and feel.



TEAMWORK

is working together and helping each other to reach a goal.



TRUST

is believing in someone who makes you feel safe.
